Only registered members get the following rights and benefits:

- Run for a position on the National Executive Committee (NEC)
- Volunteer for the union

- Join their collective bargaining committee
- Attend general meetings and training

Your employment within one of the classifications represented by CAPE makes you automatically covered by the collective agreement we negotiate with your employer. This means you are already paying monthly dues to CAPE and are represented in the event of a problem with the employer or in the workplace. However, you are not considered a member in good standing until you register, which limits your access to certain member privileges, ability to vote on the collective agreement and shape negotiations.
